## CONTINUING THE FOUNDER'S CALL

Our founder, Saint John Baptist de La Salle, was born to a wealthy family in Reims, France, but his Saintly mission was to sacrifice everything to educate the young, especially the underprivileged. He created a community to train young teachers in order to provide children with a human and Christian education. This special teacher's community that served God and young people became the Brothers of the Christian Schools, a global Institute for education focused on the Lasallian mission to serve. The thread of service to those in need weaves together Lasallians in eighty countries, and connects more than thirty ministries in the District of Eastern North America (DENA) into "One La Salle".

Lasallian students are called to service through their faith in God, and through the vision of St. John Baptist de La Salle who touched the hearts of so many. Whether it be the kindness, compassion, and acceptance students show each other every day, the individual service of a student to a favorite cause, or a school-wide program, service to others rooted in the gospel message of Jesus Christ is part of the fabric of Lasallian schools. Service, in which the needs of others are put before self, helps to build bonds that connect students to the Lasallian mission and their faith long after graduation day.

If you peruse the websites of the schools in our District, you will see that Lasallian students serve those in need in a wide variety of ways. The Lasallian Youth program within its various

ministries is one way for students to engage in the Lasallian mission through direct service projects. As one example, Lasallian students widely participate in the collection and delivery of food and necessities for those in need throughout the year. Service to local communities is a priority.

In Brooklyn NY, students at Bishop Loughlin High School rake leaves, plant trees, and pack meals at a local food bank. Service, faith, and justice are inextricably connected, and there are Social Justice Clubs throughout DENA ministries, such as La Salle Academy Providence RI, where the Social Justice Club is devoted to serving those who live in poverty in Providence. This year, students at Saint John's College High School in Washington DC marked Lasallian Social Justice Week with education and activities designed to gain a deeper understanding of homelessness. They also packed food and care packages for the most vulnerable in their community. La Salle College High School in Wyndmoor PA has a Homeless Outreach program in which students serve food, and provide clothing and friendship to those living on the streets in Center City Philadelphia.

As part of One La Salle, schools of our District also strive to serve the global community. Most of our DENA schools take part in our Lasallian Twinning program, forming ties with their "twinned" school in the Lasallian District of Lwanga in Africa. Fundraisers at each US school provide the twinned school with much needed help for school fees and food for children, the salaries of teachers, and other essential projects. Twinning, however, is not simply about sending money to Africa. Throughout the year, US students and the students at their Twinned school in Africa interact with and learn about each other through classes and

# SCHOOL SPOTLIGHT

## SAINT RAPHAEL ACADEMY - PAWTUCKET, RI

From a small, one-building, boys-only school of fifty-nine students in 1924 to a college-style co-ed campus of eight buildings serving 450 students, Saint Raphael Academy (SRA) is thriving into its 100<sup>th</sup> year!

Saint Raphael Academy will begin a year-long centennial celebration this fall that will include events for students, alumni, and friends. The school has grown and changed over the last century, yet the tenets of faith, service, and community still ring true. Today, there is a strong Lasallian spirit throughout our faculty and administration, carrying on the teachings of Saint John Baptist de La Salle and the traditions of the Christian Brothers.

Principal Daniel Richard has been at the helm for twelve years, and has overseen a thirty-five percent increase in enrollment, an expansion of the campus footprint, and a highly successful capital campaign. In addition, SRA welcomes international students from seven different countries (including another Lasallian school in Spain) who come to Pawtucket to experience an American education.

Saint Raphael Academy is poised to continue providing a strong college-preparatory education for students. The last capital campaign, "The Next 100 Years," which began just before the pandemic hit, well exceeded its \$5 million goal. Funds are being used to establish an endowment and for classroom improvements. The school just completed the ten-year renewal of its New England Association of Schools and Colleges accreditation, earning the highest ratings. It is also participating in Catholic University of America's new Lumen Accreditation program through the Diocese of Providence.

The school is still known for its excellent athletics program. In the last five years, SRA athletics has seen nearly twenty state division championships, eight state Gatorade Players of the Year (six in the running program alone), and a School of the Year recognition from the RI Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association (RIIAAA).

SRA has robust extracurricular offerings ranging from newer clubs like robotics, Spikeball Club, and Dungeons & Dragons, along with clubs that have spanned the decades like Model Legislature, Future Business Leaders Association, and Mock Trial. The SRA Cultures Club was formed to celebrate and recognize the varied cultures at the Academy. The ever-popular drama program has been going strong and has represented Rhode Island at the New England Drama Festival twice in the last two years. Saints Drama was proud to receive twelve awards during the first annual PPAC Rising Star Awards for its production of *Mary Poppins Jr.* in 2023.

Saint Raphael Academy is extremely proud of its alumni, and the Hall of Fame inducted its third class of honorees in April, recognizing alumni for their commitment to service and to the academy. The Lasallian heritage lives on through approximately ten thousand SRA graduates.

video calls. The relationships built each year between the student bodies of the schools strengthen their understanding of the global Lasallian family. Several of our schools have been inspired to take on other international support projects, like CBA Albany, where the UNICEF Club organized a 'trunk-or-treat' event to raise funds for humanitarian aid to children throughout the world.

Student service immersion trips are another opportunity for transformative experiences for students throughout DENA. Students leave their home and comfort zone to spend time with those in need and assist them as needed. At the La Salle Educational Center in Homestead FL, students provide educational and recreational opportunities for the children of low income and migrant families. At the De La Salle Blackfeet

School in Browning MT the experience includes tutoring students and learning about their families and the challenges they face as American Indians living on a reservation. La Salle College High School has received the Saint Francis of Assisi Service Award for their commitment to service at Saint Michael's Indian School. Over the past fifteen years, La Salle has sent more than three hundred students and faculty to Arizona for community service at the

school, and for an immersion experience with the Navajo Nation.

Service opportunities at our Lasallian schools are designed to shine a light on the great needs that exist in our world. Lasallian schools, in the spirit of Saint John Baptist de La Salle, foster an awareness of the many challenges faced by the economically poor, and the interconnectedness of the local and world communities in which we love our neighbor as ourselves. As students carry forward the service mission of our Founder, through experience and reflection, they gain a mature understanding of their personal responsibility to actively help those in need, building God's Kingdom here on earth.

# BROTHER SPOTLIGHT

Thomas Lackey, FSC



I was born in Detroit in 1947, and educated in grade school by the Sisters of Charity. They were the kindest women, although I will admit that riding my bike a mile to serve 6:00am Mass at their convent was not my favorite thing to do.

When I entered De La Salle Collegiate in Detroit (DLS), they had many young Brothers who really engaged their students inside and outside of the classroom. They affirmed me. We played handball outside after school, and they would open the gym and play basketball with a group of my friends (yes, a clique of nerds).

Upon graduation, I chose the University of Notre Dame because it offered a course of intensive German to prepare for a week in Innsbruck, Austria. In Europe, my life was opened to architecture, art, opera and classical music. But, I still felt the call to be a Brother. After novitiate, I was assigned to Christian Brothers Academy in Lincroft NJ (CBA), teaching world history to a large hall of 100 freshmen! Can you imagine? Then back to my *alma mater*, where I taught Asian Studies. At both CBA and DLS, I started student soccer programs with other Brothers.

After a two-year sabbatical at the University of Michigan to learn about Asian Studies, I returned to DLS and, reluctantly, became an administrator. But even in that role, I learned that I could win and touch the hearts of all different types of students.

Following a blur of powerful, unexpected experiences, I was assigned to St. Joseph's Collegiate Institute in Buffalo in campus ministry. One of the most moving experiences for me is the annual Kairos Retreat, where we touch so many hearts. I am so inspired by the seniors who attend. And, I do cry every time I give my speech about God's friendship in my life.

I'm still not ready to retire. I have too much energy. And I experience holy moments each day with the students, faculty, and staff. Their presence keeps me going, and I know new adventures await.

I am thankful to have been called to be a Christian Brother and to have been touched by so many people.

## "WE HAVE REMEMBERED THE CHRISTIAN BROTHERS"

We recently spoke to John (Jack) & Mary Lou Voge. They are a beautiful couple who live in West Chester PA, and they have decided to include the Brothers of the Christian Schools in their estate plans. Jack says that of course his children will be taken care of, but that he and Mary Lou feel strongly that the Lord has blessed them, so they must give back.

Jack, originally from Staten Island NY, began high school at St. Peter's Boys High School. Unfortunately, halfway through his sophomore

year, his family moved to Pennsylvania for his father's career as a master mariner. Jack's older brother, Donald was an alumnus of St. Peter's. Donald also worked his way up to master mariner during his nearly fifty-year career, unfortunately passing away before retirement.

"Even though I was only with the Christian Brothers for about a year and a half, they had a tremendous impact on my life. They gave me a direction, discipline (not appreciated at the time), and a desire to work with and help others." Jack continued, "I especially know that my brother Donald credited the Christian Brothers with giving him the discipline and knowledge to succeed. He would have liked the idea of giving back."

The lack of guidance and personal attention in public high school was a setback for Jack. After traveling the world for eight years on an oil tanker, he was ready to matriculate at West Chester University for teaching. It was during this period that he found his calling in real estate, which lasted for fifty years.

At the time Jack became a Realtor, he saw that there were sections of the county that were underserved. Realizing this, he focused much of his time and effort guiding clients who were at a disadvantage when it came to the home buying process. Using his contacts in the industry, he found assistance for many families who would otherwise be unable to purchase a home.

Mary Lou is also excited about helping the Brothers. "As a teacher myself, I know what a vital role the right teaching environment can have on our youth, and the Brothers continue to do an amazing job," she said. "We also plan to support several local charities that are close to our hearts, but the Christian Brothers definitely deserve our support."

## LASALLIAN STUDENTS RAISE FUNDS FOR VETERANS

An ergathon, a fundraising event in which rowers compete against each other, raised nearly \$27,000 to purchase service dogs for injured soldiers through a donation to the Lt. Dennis W. Zilinski II Memorial Fund. Lt. Zilinski, a CBA and West Point graduate, was killed in action in 2005. Two students from Christian Brothers Academy in Lincroft NJ (CBA), Jack Keavey and Robert Earle, organized the event. Designed to raise awareness about wounded US service men and women, this was Jack's community service project.

attended the event along with their son Matt who was about to deploy to Syria with the US Army.

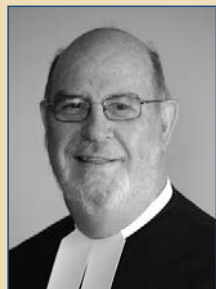

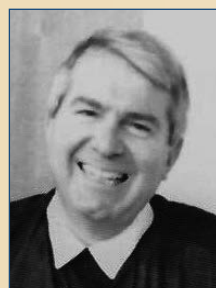


### **BROTHER STEPHEN CAPLICE, FSC** **1937 - 2024**

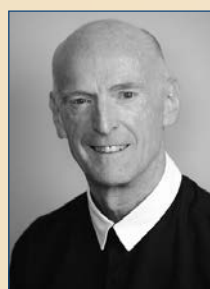


### **BROTHER HENRY WERNER, FSC** **1938 - 2024**
